Chairperson Hudson opened the special called meeting at 5:30 p.m. There was one item to discuss, due to the early termination of the grounds contract.

## **New Business:**

**The First Order of New Business** was an update from Director Warwick regarding the lawn maintenance contract with All Seasons Lawn Care coming to an end on March 31, 2020. Director Warwick said that All Seasons has had this job for 12 years, and there have occasionally been staffing problems.

She requested that the Commission allow her to put out bids for this service, to be run in The Courier on March 1<sup>st</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>. Bids should be opened on Wednesday, March 18, 2020, and decisions made by the Finance Committee and City Council. "I feel City Council will make a good decision," stated Director Warwick. There are requirements in the bid packet for the contract. Commissioner Startup made a motion to allow Director Warwick to advertise the bid, and Liaison Keller seconded the motion.
